WHEN is the retreat?

WHERE is the retreat?

The NC Baptist Assembly is located at Fort Caswell, Oak Island in Brunswick County. The retreat center is on a peninsula overlooking the point where the Cape Fear River meets the Atlantic Ocean, with spectacular views and miles of white beach.
