



The Five Pillars

1. Deepen the Faith life of the Parish:

If we look toward the future, what would enliven us on our faith journey?

How have you been formed in your faith? What worked? What did you desire more?

Where do you or your family feel a desire to grow in faith now? How would you be able to do that better?

2. Unity:

What experiences have you had around unity/division in your personal life? In the parish? How would you like to know other groups of the Parish (e.g. school, other cultural groups, other language groups, other demographic/age/professional groups, other points of view about our faith/liturgy/politics)? Why is this important to you? How could we work together to make this a reality?

3. Provide opportunities to serve and effect change (both within the parish and in the wider community):

We know we don't only live here at the parish -- are there ways that you or your loved ones experience social, economic, or political pressure that you would want to share?

Are there passions you have to make a change-- where does that come from for you?

4. Establish Financial Stability & Sustainability:

How do you understand financial stewardship in your own life? How has this parish given you an opportunity to be generous? In what ways do you hope the parish would be a good financial steward in the years ahead and what would you like the parish to focus their stewardship efforts on?

5. Address Facility and Administrative Needs:

How have the Parish structures, space, or staff affected your participation in Parish events or activities? What has been good? What could be improved? What is your experience in dealing with event planning based on coordination of space? Do you have any practical suggestions for the future of our facilities?
